

Honoa te whakautu ki te pātai tika

Match the question to the answer



Teacher Instruction:

The learners are given a question and an answer, they must match the answer to the question.

Print the questions and answers on to card, and cut along the lines.

Depending on the level of the students, remove the ‘pātai’ and ‘whakautu’ labels. Change the language of the questions and answers depending on the level of students’ language.

Put student instructions and cut up sentences into a plastic sealable bag for students to use, and then check their sentences.

Pātai:	He aha te tae o ngā makawe o Te Ata?
Whakautu:	He parauri te tae o ngā makawe o Te Ata.
Pātai:	He aha tō parakuihi i te ata nei?
Whakautu:	He patarau taku parakuihi i te ata nei.
Pātai:	E hia te utu o te pēkana?
Whakautu:	E waru tāra, e toru tekau hēneti.
Pātai:	Ko wai ō mātua?
Whakautu:	Ko Māhina rāua ko Waka aku mātua.

Student Activity Card



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He Tohutohu ki ngā Ākonga:

E 4 ngā pātai, e 4 anō ngā whakautu. Ko tāu, he hono i te whakautu tika ki ia pātai.

He tīwhiri, he kupu ārahi:

- Pānuitia ngā rerenga kōrero katoa i te tīmatanga.
- Ko ngā tohutuhi hei ārahi i a koe. Hei tauira, mehemea e tū mai ana he tohupātai, ā kāti, he pātai tonu tērā.
- Whakarārangitia mai ngā pātai ki te taha mauī me ngā whakautu ki te taha matau.
- Kimihia ētahi atu tīwhiri i roto tonu i ngā kōrero. Hei tauira, mehemea ka tīmata te pātai ki ngā kupu ‘E hia te utu....?’, me tō mōhio ko te moni tērā e kōrerotia ana, me kimi he whakautu ko te kupu ‘tāra’, ko te kupu ‘hēneti’ rānei kei roto.
